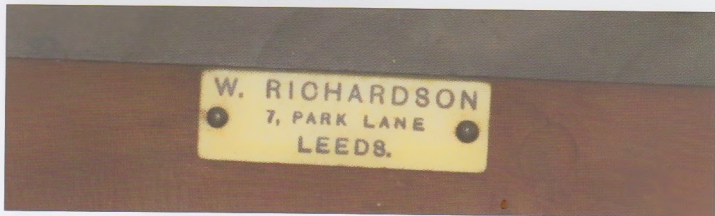


# A Leeds Chest of Drawers
