Makepeace explores the philosophy, forms and techniques of a man who has achieved world renown for the unique way in which he has seamlessly combined design, craft, architecture, the environment and conservation within a single holistic vision.

Divided into five chapters, it looks at the innovative and exquisitely crafted furniture designs of John Makepeace; his home and school at Parnham House in Dorset; his pioneering ventures into the use of sustainable resources in architecture at Hooke Park; and new directions for design and craftsmanship in the 21st century.
