

# Lionel and Ann Reynolds

It was with great sadness that we heard of the death of Ann Reynolds, of Walsingham, Norfolk, on 8 July this year. Lionel, her late husband, had died two years earlier, on 1 July 2006.

Lionel and Ann were members of the Regional Furniture Society from the earliest days, and were remarkable in their willingness to travel long distances from their large, rambling home in Holt to attend society events, and share in the life of the society.
